Pharmacists		
General	Licensed Pharmacist. *	\$289
Joint	This is for married couples who are both licensed pharmacists. *	\$449
Retired	Pharmacist who is no longer actively practicing pharmacy, but wishes to stay involved with KPhA.	\$70
Graduate	Pharmacist who graduates from pharmacy school in the current year of membership. *	Free
Graduate I	Pharmacist who graduated the year prior to the current year of membership. *	\$89
Graduate II	Pharmacist who graduated two years prior to the current year of membership. *	\$189
Faculty Professional	Full-time School of Pharmacy Faculty Personnel. Must be willing to present at a KPhA Education Program at no charge to KPhA at least once a year (Schedule Permitting).	\$25
Resident	Must be currently practicing in a residency program.	\$10
Student Pharmacist/Intern	Currently enrolled as a student at a school of pharmacy. Students do not have the right to vote.	\$10
Pharmacy Technician	Registered pharmacy technician with the State Board of Pharmacy. Technicians do not have the right to vote.	\$25
Associate	Individuals who work in a pharmacy practice environment and are interested in advancing the profession, but are not pharmacists, residents, students or technicians and do not qualify as professional or corporate members due to their employer (i.e: school of pharmacy faculty members, board of pharmacy employees, pharmacy owners/managers, etc.) Associate members receive the same member benefits as a Pharmacist member, but do not have the right to vote.	\$289

Bundled	Includes two (2) pharmacists and all technicians in one (1) location.	\$399
Chain and Regional	Must have 10 or more locations in Kansas and all locations must participate (out of state locations are optional) includes all pharmacists and all technicians per location.	\$350
Professional	Dedicated to one member representative. Must be a company that supports, advances and helps Kansas pharmacy profession as a whole by providing valuable resources to KPhA members. Practicing pharmacists can join at this level if they wish to represent an employer versus themselves.	\$400
Corporate	Professional Member with more association benefits, such as additional member representatives with KPhA and more company exposure and engagement with KPhA members. Practicing pharmacists can join at this level if they wish to represent an employer versus themselves.	Multiple Levels Available
