



Steps in Responding to an Opioid Overdose

Step 1

Call for help by dialing 911

Step 2

**Check for signs of an opioid overdose
(see Signs of Opioid Overdose)**

Step 3

**Support the person's breathing by making sure the
their airway is clear and administering CPR if trained**

Step 4

Administer naloxone

Step 5

**Roll person on to their side to minimize the chance
of them aspirating or choking if they vomit**

Step 6

**Monitor the person's response until emergency
medical services arrive**
